They were able to choose the apprenticeships they wanted. Richard, Jasper, Godfred B, and Emmanuel A are in Aveyime learning electrical. They are now able to wire rooms, fix main switches and meters. Joshua is learning welding. He said he can make a container to be used for shores, build stands for polytanks, and create coal pots. Jonah and John are in Mepe learning carpentry. They are able to make doors, store shelves, window and door locks. Emmanuel B, Daniel and Bismarck are in Sege learning Auto mechanics. Bright and Godfred A are in Sogakope for driving school. They are taking their driving test this week.
