First idols of the heart question:

worry about?**

don't get your way?**

Third idols of the heart question:

**What do you
daydream about?**

Fourth idols of the heart question:

**What makes you feel
the most self-worth?**

Fifth idols of the heart question:

**What do you lead with
in conversations?**

Sixth idols of the heart question:

**What do you really
want and expect out of
life?**

Seventh idols of the heart question:

**What is your hope for
the future?**

Finally, the last idols of the heart question:

**What area of your life
isn't fully surrendered
to Jesus?**
