I commit to the following as a member of the 2021 Pantano Christian Church Rocky Point Short-Term Mission team:

- Conduct myself in a manner that represents Jesus and His Church in a worthy manner.
- Submit to the Pantano leadership team, and the staff of 1Mission.
- Participate/engage in all team meetings and debriefs.
- Strive to work as a member of the larger team, putting others' needs above my own.
- Refrain from any sleeping accommodations with an individual other than my spouse or a member of my immediate family (Unless pre-approved by Pantano leadership team).
- Refrain from the use of any alcohol/illegal substances.
- Refrain from criticizing others around me.
- Not transport any firearms/ammunition or other weapons into or out of Mexico.
- For those driving a vehicle – Secure Mexican auto insurance for the vehicle I will drive, and understand that Pantano strongly recommends a vehicle check-up before departure.
- Abide by Mexico laws.
- Not leave Mexico before the end of the trip without expressed permission of the trip leader or other Pantano staff.

Participants under 18 years of age are the responsibility of the parent/guardian and have been instructed in and agree to all of the above.

I understand and accept the guidelines laid out within this document. Should I or any member of my family become unwilling or unable to meet the requirements of this document, I understand that my/their spot on the team may be forfeited. As such, it is understood that mission work is demanding and thus we promise to give our whole self, allowing God to work in and through us.
