Abel does not have very steady work. He works occasionally cleaning streets where he can earn about \$25 a week. He also is in treatment for diabetes and high cholesterol.

Abel always lived with his mother, but when she passed away 15 years ago, her house and land were sold and divided between Abel and his sisters. He used the money to purchase a land lot which is where he has been living in a room he constructed using salvaged material. His home is in very poor condition, he has no electricity and it offers little comfort or protection from the elements. A house from 1MISSION would give Abel a safe and secure home where he could live comfortably while focusing his limited resources on meeting his daily needs.
