

Rocky Point Packing List

- Passport (or copy of birth certificate for children under 19)
- Tent with heavy duty stakes – the ground is very hard or RV or travel trailer
- Sleeping Bag/Pillow
- Foam/Air Mattress/Cot (don't sleep directly on the ground!)
- Long extension cord and fan to keep cool at night if hot
- Personal Toiletries (including toothpaste, shampoo, soap, towels, flip flops for shower, ear plugs) Showers are available at campsite.
- Sunscreen
- Swim shoes & snorkeling gear can be nice to have
- Jacket or sweatshirt (it can get cold at night/early morning)
- Toilet paper (just in case)
- First-aid Kit (aspirin, band-aids, cleanser, Imodium, eye drops)
- Prescription drugs in original labeled bottles
- Flashlight (bring extra batteries)
- Personal drinking containers I.D. marked (for job site)
- Photo ID (Drivers license or School ID)
- Hat or visor
- Sunglasses
- Safety glasses (if you have them)
- Bathing suit (please be modest)
- Bible, notebook, pen, study materials
- Lawn chair/camp stool/tables
- Lantern
- Mexican Travel Insurance (Please purchase prior to leaving)
- Suitable work shoes (no sandals/open toed shoes at job site)
Boots/tennis shoes are okay
- Suitable work clothes (jeans, t-shirts, sweat pants, long sleeve shirts, etc)
- Work gloves (everyone working on houses)
- Tape measure (one per person). Not required, but bring if you can.
- Nail pouch (one per person). Not required, but bring if you can.
- Pencils (one per person)
- Hammer (one per person). Not required, but bring if you can.
- Handsaw (sharp). Not required, but bring if you can.
- Sponges (for stucco work). Not required, but bring if you can.
- Games, beach toys (football, vball, paddle ball, Frisbee)
- Snacks of your own liking
